Secretary's Report



- ♦ The United Nations Climate Change Conference took place in Copenhagen during December 7-18, 2009.
- ♦ Nepal's Cabinet met at the base of Everest on December 4, 2009 to highlight the impact of climate change on the Himalayas.
- ♦ The Ministry of Environment and Forests and ISRO plan to set up a national institute of climate and environment in Bengaluru.
- Dr. Radhakrishnan took over as Chairman ISRO, and secretary DOS.
- ♦ The cyclonic storm Phyan crossed Maharashtra coast on November 11, 2009. It caused loss of seven human lives. Another deep depression along Tamil Nadu coast developed into a cyclonic storm named 'Ward' on December 11, 2009 and gradually weakened after crossing north Sri Lanka coast.
- Southern tip of India witnessed an annular solar eclipse on January 15, 2010.
- 16th National Space Science Symposium will be held at Saurashtra University, Rajkot during February 24-27, 2010.
- 29th Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica has left to Antarctica in November 2009
- ♦ A joint International workshop on Impact of Climate Change on Agriculture was held during December 17-18, 2009 at SAC, Ahmedabad.

Monsoon Lecture by Dr. R. Krishnan

On December 21, 2009, Dr. R. Krishnan, Head, Climate & Global Modeling Division, Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Pune gave a Monsoon mid-latitude lecture on and interactions during droughts over India: Special focus on the 2009 monsoon. This lecture was held at SAC Bopal campus. Dr. Krishnan talked about Indian summer monsoon and mid-latitude interactions during breaks. He proposed a feedback mechanism that occurs during the breaks. According to his hypothesis, these breaks involve suppressed convection, inducing Rossby waves in the mid-latitude, which in turn advects cold air from mid-latitude westerly troughs. This leads to anomalous cooling of middle and upper troposphere and decreases meridional temperature gradient over the Indian longitude that re-enforces the break monsoon condition. The proposed hypothesis requires detailed investigation for other suppressed monsoon years.

Copenhagen Climate Change Summit

The UN Climate Change Conference took place in Copenhagen during December 7-18, 2009. The conference included the 15th Conference of the Parties (COP 15) to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change and the 5th Meeting of the Parties (COP/MOP 5) to the Kyoto Protocol. A framework for climate change mitigation beyond 2012 was to be agreed there. In this regard India has already declared that it would consider a carbon intensity cut of 20-25% by 2020, but has made it clear that it would not be forced into accepting legally binding cuts in greenhouse gas emissions.
